

# Intellectual Property Rights Policy

Except as noted in Section 1.3, information disclosed in connection with any Working Group activity, including but not limited to Contributions, submissions and other information disclosed in connection with meetings, can be shared with the general IoT Talent Consortium membership.

This Intellectual Property Rights Policy (the "IPR Policy") is the governing document for all intellectual property rights ("IPR") policies of the IoT Talent Consortium.

## 1.0 IPR Principles

### 1.1 Contributions

"Contribution" means any written or electronic statement or other material made or presented by a party (the "Contributor") and expressly identified by the submitter or another representative of the submitter's company as a Contribution. Material designated as a "Contribution" is subject to use by the IoT Talent Consortium, as further set forth herein, solely in connection with the IoT Talent Consortium's mission, purposes and activities (the "Purpose"). All member representatives are responsible for ensuring that they have permission from their companies (or other copyright holder) to make their Contributions to the IoT Talent Consortium, which subjects these Contributions to the rights of internal or public use and licensing set forth in the sections below. Notwithstanding the foregoing, any member may contest a Contribution that contains intellectual property owned by that member for which written permission has not been obtained and such Contribution was not submitted by that member. In such a case, such member would have 14 days after the applicable working group makes the Contribution known to the members to contest the Contribution.

### 1.2 No Technical Development

The IoT Talent Consortium does not adopt technical specifications or specify technologies to be used.

### 1.3 Copyright

Each Contributor agrees to grant, and hereby grants, IoT Talent Consortium a nonexclusive, irrevocable, sublicensable, royalty-free, paid up, worldwide license, under its copyright in the Contribution, to copy and modify the Contribution, to make derivative works from it, and to distribute the Contribution and copies of any such modifications and derivative works solely in connection with the Purpose. No Contribution may be made to the IoT Talent Consortium unless the Contributors are the copyright owners of the Contribution or have sufficient rights from the copyright owners to make the Contribution under the terms of this Policy. The Contributor must disclose the identities of all copyright owners in the Contribution.

#### **1.4 Trademark**

All members of the IoT Talent Consortium grant the IoT Talent Consortium and any consortium administrator the right to use the name of the member's organization on the IoT Talent Consortium and consortium administrator websites and on related marketing materials, solely to indicate the Member's participation in the Working Groups in the IoT Talent Consortium.

#### **1.5 Patents**

Except as otherwise enacted as an IoT Talent Consortium policy, no patent license or rights are granted (whether by implication, estoppel, or otherwise) by any Member(s) to any other Member(s) or third parties.
